



Secretary Jeff Epstein

Jeff Epstein, a business executive from Charlotte, was appointed Secretary for the North Carolina Department of Revenue (NCDOR) in January 2016.

Prior to his appointment as Secretary, Epstein served as the department's Chief Operating Officer, overseeing the agency's day-to-day business operations. In this role, he led the NCDOR's efforts to implement tax reform legislation which modernized the state's corporate and individual income tax code. Additionally, Epstein initiated critical customer service projects including the development of the Office of the Taxpayer Advocate and launch of a new taxpayer assistance call center which significantly improved taxpayer access to the agency.

Before joining state government, Epstein was Founder and President of Valuebiz, a Charlotte based office furniture company. Additionally, he served as Managing Partner of Marjorie Capital, which developed commercial real estate in the Charlotte area, and as a Senior Advisor in the Charlotte office of VR Mergers and Acquisitions, a consultant to buyers and sellers of family-owned businesses.

Epstein has a degree in Finance from The American University. While in Washington, he served as a member of the White House advance team during the Reagan Administration. Since moving to North Carolina in 1989, Epstein has served in numerous community service leadership roles in Mecklenburg County.
