Estimate Your Tax Due



- Use the **Income Tax Estimator** to figure out what you will owe and, if applicable, adjust your NC-4 or estimated tax payments to avoid having a balance due.

- Increasing the tax withheld from each paycheck may help you avoid having a balance due when you file.

Know Your Payment Options



- Pay online using **eFile or Online File and Pay**.
- Pay by phone or pay by mail.
- Make sure the eFile software you choose supports payments.

Pay in Full or Schedule Payments



- Pay in full by the due date to avoid penalties and interest.
- Use **eFile or Online File and Pay** to file early and schedule payments up until the due date.
