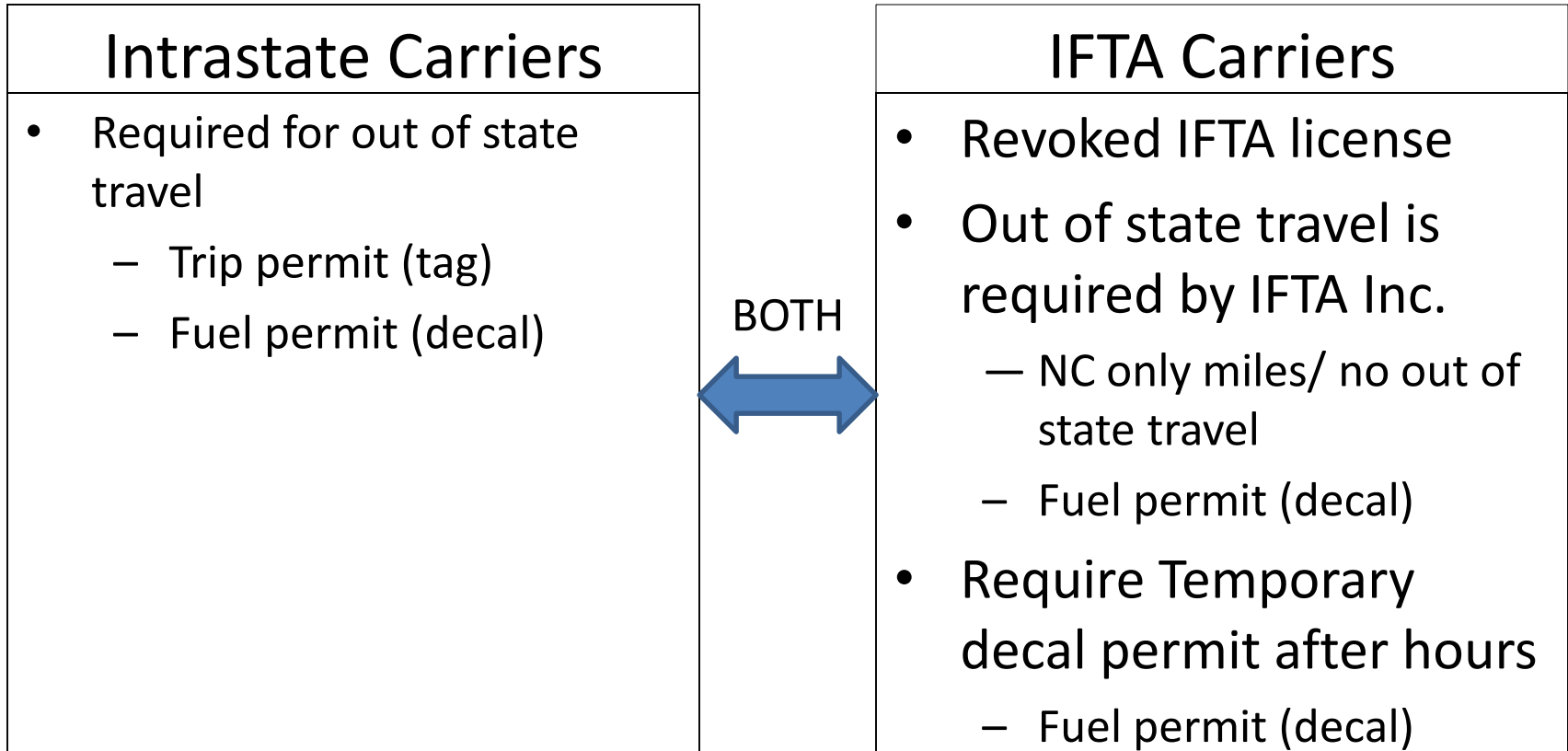

Temporary Trip Permits Purpose for Use

- All Motor Carriers who do not possess the proper credentials to travel outside the state of North Carolina





Temporary Trip Permits Issuance

- Arrange your travel prior to entering the state
- Issued by jurisdiction and permitting services
- Temporary Trip Permit (tag)
 - Additional permits may apply
 - Additional fees may apply
- Temporary Fuel Permit (decal)
- Must contact jurisdictions individually



Temporary Trip Permits Issuance

- Pricing for permits vary by jurisdiction
- # of days valid vary by jurisdiction
- Obtaining the valid credentials

Example				
Temporary Permit Pricing				
Jurisdiction	Trip Permit \$	# of days valid	Fuel Permit \$	# of days valid
South Carolina	\$15	3 days	\$15	10 days
Virginia	\$15	10 days	\$20	10 days
Georgia	\$30	3 days	\$16	10 days
Tennessee	\$30	3 days	\$30	7 days



IFTA Temporary Decal Permits Requirements

- Licensed as an IFTA motor carrier
- IFTA account must be in compliance
- Operation in any IFTA member jurisdictions
- Copy of IFTA license



IFTA Temporary Decal Permits Issuance

- Contact the North Carolina Department of Revenue Excise Tax Division
 - Business hours are 8:00 a.m. -5:00 p.m.
 - Non-business hours
- Request may be made by phone, fax or mail
 - Permit will be transmitted by fax
 - No Charge
- Valid for 30 days
